## Stage 2 Paremata wastewater upgrades - Investigations

Paremata, Porirua

Tēnā koe,

Wellington Water in conjunction with Pro-Drill is about to get underway with investigations for a project to upgrade a 4km section of wastewater main in your area.

This will increase the capacity and resilience of the local network to cater for residential growth as part of wider works to improve the city's wastewater network, protect public and environmental health.

The investigations commence on **27 November 2023** and will take around two months to complete. The work will consist of a series of ground investigations involving drilling bores and test pits along Papakowhai Road, Paremata Crescent and the centre median of SH59 to locate existing services.

These will not be overly disruptive. However, there will be traffic management in place around the worksites to ensure the safety of our crews, pedestrians and road users. This will result in some temporary loss of parking.

We have also planned hours of work to ensure minimal disruption to the local community, businesses and road users. In particular, where the work site is near Paremata School, we will be working outside of school drop-off/pick-up hours to ensure the safety of children, families and staff as follows:

- 9.30am to 2.30pm for work near Paremata School
- 9am to 4pm for investigations along Papakowhai Road and Paremata Crescent
- 7am to 6pm for SH59 centre median investigations
